Program

1. Intensive Study: "Dance in the City" Aug. 13-24

Full Day Program for Students interested in pursuing dance studies to advanced level through High School credit, performance and/or university levels. Course of Study includes Ballet technique, Variations, Modern Contemporary technique & composition, Jazz, Broadway Jazz, Pointe, Repertoire, Dance History, Stretch & Strength, Pilates, Character, Special workshops & Excursions.

Level I: Min. Grade 3 R.A.D. exam or equivalent (or special permission). Classes will be conducted at the Grade 4 to Gr.6, R.A.D. Levels.

Level II: Min. Grade level Prep. Grade 7 R.A.D. or Prep. Inter Foundation. Classes will be conducted at the Inter Foundation to Prep. Grade 7 R.A.D. Level. Ballet classes are non-Syllabus, Open Technique.

Level III: Minimum grade level: Inter Foundation exam or equivalent. Classes will be conducted at the Intermediate/Adv. level. Ballet classes are non syllabus, Open technique.
